

## Article IV

### Section 1.

J. Should a vacancy occur in any other office, the President, with approval of the Executive-Committee, shall appoint a member to temporarily serve for a period not to exceed three months. A Special Election shall be held within three (3) months after the seat has been vacated.

### K. Special Election **NEW**

A Special Election is an election held outside of the course of the regular two year term to fill vacant offices.

1. The Corresponding Secretary shall notify Members at least ten (10) days prior to a Special Election. The Notice shall state the time, place and office for which the election is held.
2. The Nominating Committee shall present the names of candidate(s) for the vacant position and make all preparation for the election.
3. The election shall occur the month after the Nominating Committee has presented the candidate(s) to the Chapter.
4. The Special Election shall be held by secret ballot. An officer shall be elected by a majority of members present and voting.
5. The new officer is elected to serve the unexpired term of her predecessor.
