Each posts featured a Black History art related fact, about local artists to local organizations such as one of our community partners, The Tacoma Urban Performing Arts Center (TUPAC).

A movie night was hosted by the Facet to close out the month of February to bring Link sisters and strengthen sisterhood with newly inducted Link sisters. This event was also intended to celebrate and watch outstanding performances by Black actors featured in Ma Rainey's Black Bottom.

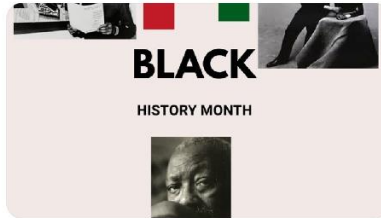
