**Description of the program/activity:**

- Tacoma Symphony – Mini Maestros: The Arts Facet, as a community partner financially sponsored the season of programming for the Mini Maestros by contributing \$1000 for the 2020-2021 Education Program Sponsorship.
- Virtual Vision Board: Artistic activity hosted by the Art Facet creating space for Link sisters to come together in the love of sisterhood and creativity to map out their personal vision and goals on any topic that is meaningful to each Link sister. - ARTSFUND and WA Department of Commerce \$2,500 to \$25,00 grant application submission:
  - The Art Facet is reviewing and preparing application for grant to expand programming opportunities. Facet will leverage previous chapter grant application (WA Equity Relief Fund for Nonprofit grant submission) as template to follow.
  - About the Grant:
    - Nonprofits help build community; their recovery is critical to a thriving post-pandemic economy and healthy communities within Washington. These pandemic recovery grants will be administered by ArtsFund to Washington nonprofits meeting the eligibility requirements listed below. Organizations that are led by and/or serve under-resourced communities, culturally diverse populations, and underrepresented groups are encouraged to apply. Grants will be distributed to nonprofits statewide in four focus areas: Arts, culture, science, and heritage. Organizations defined: any organization whose primary mission is to offer or promote artistic, creative, cultural, scientific, technology or heritage programs for the enrichment of their community. Washington State Department of Commerce is partnering with ArtsFund to center the grants program focused on the four focus areas. Grants will also be awarded to nonprofit neighborhood associations, sports and recreation organizations, and veterans organizations.
  - All applications received by the May 24 deadline will be considered.

**Outcomes:**

- Tacoma Syphony/Mini-Maestros: Community program funding for music to educate and increase awareness in orchestra for youth 2-8 years of age.
- Virtual Vision Board Party. Date: Art Facet kick off *2021-2022 program year*. Inspire and foster time for creativity and engagement.
- Grant application for ARTSFUND: TBD – goal to achieve maximum grant reward (\$25,000). These monies will be used to increase and expand chapter programming aligned to grant established criteria.
