Program Report Reminders

Recent and upcoming Facet events/activities

ARTS – The Arts Facet will partner with HHS and NTS to support two programs focused on community members experiencing homelessness:

- [The Power of Two](#) – *Power Program: “Interactive workshops to support youth in unlocking their full potential”*

On Monday, November 22nd the Arts facet members will provide a creative journaling workshop to youth experiencing homelessness. The facet will also continue to support Symphony Tacoma with anticipation of Christina Abbey’s Symphony Board appointment.

HHS – Partnering with NTS and the Arts facets to provide resources and services such as tutoring, parenting skills, mental health resources and food and clothing items in partnership with Bethlehem Baptist Church and the Power of Two.

ITS – The facet continues to support the enrollment of our student Elizabeth for her sophomore year at the I Can Fly Butterfly House. The facet is continuing to research opportunities to support women and girls within the local Kenyan Community experiencing homelessness. On Oct. 30th chapter members were invited to attend a I Can Fly International Butterfly House Coming to America 2021 event, and I Can Fly High School Campus Tour.

NTS – Held an activity for World Homeless Day on October 10th (Link Gina sending report). Continue to put together resource cards and info for social media. The facet will continue to provide clothing donations to local organizations and looking into purchasing tickets for Holiday meals for Tacoma Rescue Mission. Also checking into possibly purchasing Thanksgiving dinners from Saar’s Market Place.

STY – Will be replenishing the clothing closet at Foss High School to provide clothing, food and supplies for students experiencing homelessness.
